- 1 Under the terms of Decree-Law No. 57/2016, of August 29, in its current wording, it is hereby made public that, by resolution of the Board of Directors of IPMA, I. P., dated 3/11/2025, recorded in point 7 of minutes No. 29/2025, the opening of the international selection competitive procedure was authorized with applications to be submitted within 10 (ten) working days for the position of a PhD researcher, within the scope of the Technical Studies for Offshore Energy Potential Project, with a fixed-term public service employment contract, for a period of three years, on an exclusive dedication basis.
- 2 The job description is as follows:
- a) Coordination of sediment sampling, analysis, stratigraphy and dating by AMS14C in calcareous microorganisms;
- b) Integration of field data from geology, geophysics and environmental surveys;
- c) Coordination and management of the dissemination and dissemination of data acquired by the Project in the 2024 and 2025 campaigns and analytical and field results for the community;
- 3 Applicable legislation: a) Decree-Law No. 57/2016, of August 29, amended by Law No. b) General Law on Work in Public Functions (LTFP), approved in the annex to Law No. 35/2014, of June 20, in its current wording;
- 4 Under the terms of article 16 of the RJEC, this competitive procedure is exempt from: a) Authorization from the members of the Government responsible for the areas of finance and Public Administration, in particular that referred to in § 3 of article 7 of the LTFP, b) Obtaining the favorable prior opinion referred to in § 5 of article 30 of the LTFP and c) The procedure for recruiting workers in a situation of professional appreciation, of article 265 of the LTFP.

- 5 Only national, foreign and stateless candidates holding a Doctorate degree in Earth and Marine Sciences or related areas may participate in the competition, under penalty of exclusion.
- 6 Those who, under the terms of Decree-Law No. 66/2018 of August 16 which approved the legal regime for the recognition of academic degrees and higher education diplomas awarded by foreign higher education institutions have recognized academic degree or higher education diploma, awarded by foreign higher education institutions.
- 7 The remuneration is that of an assistant researcher, namely: (euro) 3,501.28 (index 195 of the scientific research career) to which are added the meal, holiday and Christmas allowance.
- 8 Place of work: IPMA headquarters, Rua C, Lisbon Airport; 1749-077 Lisbon and Algés delegation, located at Av. Alfredo Magalhães Ramalho, 6 1495-165 Algés.
- 9 Under the terms of article 5 of the RJEC, selection is carried out through the evaluation of the scientific and curricular path of the candidates, considering the following parameters (0 to 20 points), in an additive manner, and broken down to tenths, with proven professional experience being valued in:

- 10 The assessment of the candidate's scientific and curricular path may be completed by an interview with the five best-ranked candidates, whenever the panel so decides.
- 11 In accordance with article 13 of the RJEC, the selection board has the following composition: President: Professor Doctor José Ângelo Guerreiro da Silva, President of IPMA, I. P.; Members: Doctor Pedro António Gancedo Terrinha, Head of the Marine Geology and Georesources Division of the Portuguese Institute of the Sea and Atmosphere, I.P. and Doctor Fátima Filomena Guedes Abrantes, Coordinating Researcher of the Division of Marine Geology and Georesources of the Portuguese Institute of the Sea and Atmosphere, I.P
- 12 The jury deliberates through a nominal vote based on the selection criteria adopted and published, with no abstentions permitted.
- 13 Minutes are drawn up of the jury meetings, which contain a summary of what occurred therein, as well as the votes cast by each of the members and their respective grounds, and are made available to candidates whenever requested.
- 14 The jury's final decision requires approval by the Board of Directors of IPMA, IP.
- 15 The deadline for submitting applications for the procedure is 10 working days, counting from the day following the publication of this notice in the Public Employment Exchange (BEP).
- 16 The application must be accompanied by the following documents: a) Form available on the IPMA, IP website, which must expressly indicate which reference(s) you are applying for; b) Copy of certificate or diploma attesting to the title of Doctor in Earth and Marine Sciences or related areas; c) Doctoral thesis; d) Detailed and updated Curriculum Vitae; e) Other documents that the candidate considers relevant for the evaluation of his/her scientific and curricular path.
- 17 Candidates must submit the documents, preferably in digital format, in PDF format, to the email address recrutamento@ipma.pt, in person at Rua C ao Aeroporto de Lisboa, 1749-077 Lisboa, during office hours (10am/4pm), or by post to the same address. When sent by post, the mail must be registered, with acknowledgement of receipt, sent by the last day of the competition opening period.
- 18 The following are excluded from the competition: a) Candidates who incorrectly formalize their registration or who do not prove the required requirements; b) Candidates who do not submit the application, do not send the documentation or send

illegible, incorrectly completed or invalid documentation. c) Candidates who do not indicate the procedure for which they are applying.

- 19 The board has the right to require any candidate, in case of doubt, to present documents proving their statements.
- 20 False statements made by candidates will be punished in accordance with the law.
- 21 The lists of admitted and excluded candidates as well as the final classification lists are published on the website http://www.ipma.pt/pt, with candidates being notified by email with receipt of delivery of the notification.
- 22 Under the terms of article 121 of the Code of Administrative Procedure, after notification, candidates have 10 working days to respond in writing. The jury's final decisions will be made within 90 days of the deadline for submitting applications.
- 23 This competition is exclusively intended to fill the indicated vacancy and may be terminated until the final classification lists of candidates are approved and will expire with the respective occupation of the jobs on offer.
- 24 IPMA, IP actively promotes a policy of non-discrimination and equal opportunities and access to employment, in accordance with article 9 of the Constitution.
- 25 The board approved this notice at the meeting held on March 21, 2025.
